DELF

Diplôme d'études en langue française

An international diploma awarded by the French Ministry of Education to certify the competency of candidates in the French language.

A proof of language proficiency that opens a world of academic and professional opportunities!

- Life-long diploma
- Internationally recognized
- Valid for external credits in BC (Grades 10 to 12)
- Enhances education and career opportunities
- Useful for post-secondary admissions in French speaking countries (B2 level)



DEL^F LEVELS

The DELF tests French language proficiency for ages 11 to 18.

It has four levels: A1, A2, B1, and B2 following the Common European Framework of Reference for languages (CEFR)

A1 LEVEL

The exam focuses on basic communication skills in French, such as asking and answering simple questions, and engaging in basic conversations.

A2 LEVEL

The exam tests the ability to communicate more effectively in French, with a focus on more complex grammatical structures and vocabulary.

B1 LEVEL

The exam assesses the ability to understand and participate in discussions on a range of topics, with an emphasis on expressing opinions and providing arguments.

B2 LEVEL

The exam tests the ability to understand and produce written and spoken language on more abstract and complex topics, such as politics, culture, and society.

All tests are **divided into two sections**: a collective or group exam (*listening and reading comprehension, written production*) and an individual exam (*oral production and interaction*).

DELF

French language diploma for children & teens

The DELF has been tailored for children and teens and allows them to **validate and certify their French language abilities**. It can also be used to qualify for **school credits**.

DELF Prim: 8 to 11 years old

- Open to all candidates. Exam tailored for children 8 to 11 years old.
- Two session / year.
- Available levels: A1.1, A1, A2.
- Registration through Alliance Francaise Vancouver.

DELF Junior: 12 to 18 years old

- Open to all candidates. Exam tailored for teenagers.
- Two session / year.
- Available levels: A1, A2, B1, B2.
- Registration through Alliance Francaise Vancouver.

DELF Scolaire: 12 to 18 years old

- Registration through the candidate's school.
- Teacher and/or school must contact Alliance Francaise Vancouver to organize the exam.
- Two session / year.
- Available levels: A1, A2, B1, B2.



DELF EXTERNAL CREDITS

DELF certification qualifies for external credits under the **British Columbia Ministry of Education External Credentials Program**.

Collective Exam

OR at your school. If you have more than 30 candidates, the collective exam can take place in your school. Please contact us for more information.

Individual Exam

At Alliance Francaise Vancouver. each candidate will receive an individual appointment within two weeks of the collective exam.
